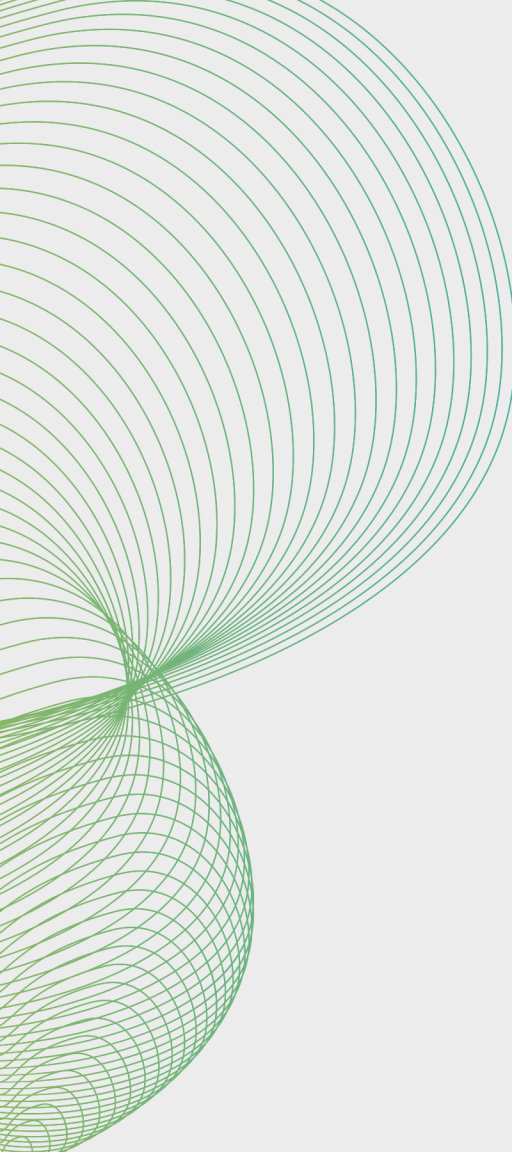




REPORT OF THE YOUTH ORGANIZATION "STAN" FOR 2021





The whole of 2021 was characterized by capacity building and development of the expertise of STAN team members. We felt like a youth outpost of human rights and solidarity in the region, strengthening and developing the organization's institutional capacity to become an independent agent of change.





Our activities aimed to form a culture of human rights and solidarity, strengthen intercultural dialogue and contacts between people, and encourage young people to become a part of the decision-making process.

During 2021, the organization's management has significantly improved. STAN employed 14 people. The team has a full portfolio of competencies and expertise in designing and facilitating educational programs, promoting cultural diversity, human rights, gender equality, social inclusion, community cohesion, social entrepreneurship, peacebuilding, and people-to-people contacts through open dialogue.







The organization opened an office of 104 m2 in the historic part of the city.

The Human Rights Youth Resource Center for activists has been operating there since May 2021.

It hosted educational events, partnership meetings, and small conferences.



During 2021, an analysis of the external environment, current trends, and the needs of the beneficiaries of the organisation was conducted. Team members developed research publications based on the regional community mapping process. Even more, open dialogue about peace methodology was created and implemented in 5 regions of Ukraine.
